MOSCOW, IDAHO

In the USA there are many cities, towns and villages which are namesakes (*тёзки*) not only of Moscow and Odessa, but also of London, Paris, Rome, Geneva and so on. In the USA, for example, there are big- and small-populated places in 15 states which have the name of Moscow. One such Moscow is the administrative centre in Idaho. How did these namesakes of European cities come to the American continent? In the 1880's a lot of people from Europe went to America to start a new life. People of different nationalities, including Russians and Ukrainians, settled in new places but they did not forget their home towns and villages. They named their new villages and towns in honour of the places where they had been born. Many people from Europe went to the Rocky Mountains in search of gold and they called one of the settlements Moscow. Earlier that area had been populated by Indians. Today Moscow, Idaho, is a nice town, situated among green hills. Americans call it a student home, because almost 50 % (per cent) of the population are students. The University of Moscow, Idaho, founded in 1889, stands on a hill. The University's library is one of the best in the USA and has a collection of interesting books on American history. The people of Moscow, Idaho, grow a rich harvest of maize, peas and potatoes. It also has a developed industry and produces lead (*свинец*), copper (*медь*), silver and other metals.
